Growing and Developing Successful Writers

- Year 3 and 5 students to make improvements in text structure and sentence structure in NAPLAN Writing based on 2016 data
- Increase the number of students achieving an A or B in English in Year 1-6
- All students show growth in writing development
- Identification of 2-3 students achieving a 'C' for additional intervention and support to achieve a 'B' in English
- Maintain the school's achievement to be comparable to the nation in text structure criteria and improve student achievement

Growing and Developing Successful Readers


- Year 3 students will maintain results in MSS, NMS and U2B
- Year 5 students will increase MSS, U2B and NMS
- 13- 23% of students to make more than a year's progress in reading benchmarks
- 80% students reach F & P benchmark for year level
- All students make a year's progress for a year of reading instruction

Our initiatives include


- Use Taabinga Writing framework to embed process for writing when developing units of work in English through support from Head of Curriculum and Master Teacher.
- Provision of Peer observation time and coaching to support deliberate collaboration to implement the school writing framework with Master Teacher and Head of Curriculum
- Engagement in DDSW Writing Module 7, LSIA Writing Project and How Language Works professional learning to further develop teacher knowledge and instructional practices
- Use of data walls and teachers voice through deliberate collaboration to identify students through Case Management meetings to define instructional strategies
- Early and ongoing intervention to support good first teaching, and using data to analyse individual student performance and provide relevant and targeted support in reading
- Develop leadership team capacity to lead improvement agenda

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Additional 0.5FTE Head of Curriculum and 0.4FTE Master Teacher (\$75462)
- Teacher release in year levels weekly to engage in Case Management meetings (\$71345)
- Engagement QELI High Performing Leadership Teams (\$12 000)
- Leading Learning Communities, LSIA Writing Project, DDSW Writing Module 7 and Grammar workshops (\$11787)
