- Target teaching and intervention programs in Prep to Year 3, focusing on the development of oral language, phonological awareness, reading and numeracy
- Inclusion of all students within in the classroom
- Support Beginning Teacher to improve curriculum alignment and pedagogy
- Create smaller class sizes across the school to improve student learning outcomes

Our initiatives include

- Implementing of High Impact Strategies with the focus on consistent teaching practices across the Prep to Year 6, in particular the use of Explicit Teaching and Age Appropriate Pedagogies
- Implementing a reading Improvement Group to revamp reading across the school aligned with current research
- Embedding early intervention in Prep to Year 3
- Using the high performing team structure and intentional collaboration across the school to ensure teachers work collaboratively to plan, review and refine all teaching and learning programs
- Increasing critical thinking, with a focus on 21st Century Learning

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Purchasing of additional teacher aide support to provide intervention, and students with high needs in the classroom | \$ 94,615 |
| • Employing a full time teacher to reduce class sizes | \$ 87,716 |
| • Employing a teacher (0.2) to support beginning teachers | \$ 22,807 |
